



**The scope of this Study is as approved by DCNR. Its format follows the scope of: Rehabilitation of an Existing Facility.**


In this action, **Aquatic Facility Design, Inc.** has completed the following processes and reviews:

- A survey and assessment of the existing facility


This study includes recommendations for renovation and enhancements, along with budgetary projections so that the Borough can make informed decisions on the best solutions for their complex.

## Executive Summary

The Emmaus Community Park Swimming Pool, constructed prior to 1957, serves patrons from the East Penn School District, Lehigh County including the boroughs of Emmaus, Macungie and Alburtis as well as the Lower Macungie and Upper Milford Townships.

Beginning in 2019, feasibility design investigation for renovation of the complex was conducted.

This consisted of:

1. A visual survey and assessment of the existing facility.
2. A public participation process which consisted of interviews with key personnel of the Emmaus Steering Committee.
3. Two publicly advertised meetings in which the general public was invited to express their ideas and opinions about the future of the complex. Renovation concepts were presented at the meetings and input was received.
4. Core Boring Samplings of the Main Pool Shell

The findings of the study process and the data received support the following:

The complex consists of a Main Pool, a Wading Pool, a Bathhouse, and a Concession Building.

The complex's swimming pools are in need of renovation and reconfiguration. Although well maintained and in sound structural and physical condition, the complex's general character is no longer well suited to current public uses and trends.

The current configuration of the pools permits primarily general swimming or wading and does not meet the public's "expectations" of a modern complex. The current configurations also do not allow the management of the facility to implement such programs as the public demands and requires.

A Contemporary Aquatics Complex will provide access and activities for all age groups and activity levels. **The goal of this complex is to provide equal opportunities for educational, social, and recreational types of programs.** This would include, but is not limited to, activities such as swimming lessons, water sports, senior

fitness classes, lap swimming, competition training, splash hops, private parties etc., as well as a variety of “general recreational play type” activities.

**A reimagining of the main pool and the replacement of the wading pool is required to overcome the issues currently plaguing the complex.**

**The Main Pool will be reconstructed and refurbished as a Phase I project.**

The main pool is well maintained and of sound structural condition and accepting of long term improvements.

The pool shell will be sandblasted and all weak and hollow areas will be removed and regunited.

The pool top with the concrete gutter will be removed and a stainless steel gutter system and new piping system will be installed.

The shallow end of the pool will have a new ADA ramp and stairs installed. These will be integral to the design.

Benches with sun shades will be added to the pools footprint as a respite from the sun.

The intermediate area of the pool will have five (5) 50 meter lanes for training purposes or lap swimming. These long lanes are a unique asset to the community and to the area for the purposes of competitive training. The current zip line will remain and floatable sharks and turtles will be added for play.

The deep well area will feature diving, a climbing wall, and a single flume slide.

The base cost for the main pool improvements is estimated at .....\$1,250,000.00.

**Construction of a New Wading Pool is recommended as a Phase I project.**

A new wading pool will begin with a zero-depth entry and slope into a depth of 1’-6”. This area offers multiple children's activities and play features, with areas designated for caregivers to relax while still having visibility of their children. Sun shades are added for additional comfort.

Splash and spray features will be throughout the pool.

The base cost for the wading pool is estimated at.....\$550,000.00.

**Refurbishment of the bathhouse is recommended as a Phase I or II project.**

The Bathhouse is in excellent condition and requires moderate renovation. Fixture additions will be required to meet the user loads for the renovated complex and two new family changing rooms will be created at the entrance to the hallways in the men’s and women’s areas. A new roof is needed and cosmetic upgrades will also be made. This could be phase II project but is recommended as a phase I.

The base cost for the bathhouse renovations is estimated at .....\$425,000.00

Upgrades to the concession are recommended as a Phase I project.

The concession stand area would be upgraded with a more cleanable floor surface, an improved three bowl sink, new stainless steel countertops, and a cold bar area. Café area seating and changes to the ADA approaches to the interior and exterior serving windows would be proposed. These items are recommended in a phase I project.

The base cost for the concession renovation is estimated at .....\$155,000.00.

**Total base renovation costs are estimated at ..... \$2,380,000.00.**

Funds for improvements could be obtained from a variety of sources including DCNR grants, bond issues, loans, tax increases, private source contributions, etc. These options would be fully explored upon the desire to implement a project.


An optional splash pad will be considered between the main and wading pools. It will be themed for ages 0-8 and will feature a variety of above grade as well as flush mount spray features.

The base cost for the splash pad is estimated at .....\$450,000.00.

Parking for the complex is an issue and difficult to resolve. The only option seen as viable is to remove the playground outside the entrance to the bathhouse. A relocation site for the playground is not known at the time of this writing. This could be considered as a phase II project. (See Drawing CS-4 hereafter)

The cost is estimated at .....\$300,000.00.

In closing, we believe that the Emmaus Community Park Swimming Pool is an asset to the Borough of Emmaus, and the surrounding area. The facility is due for a renovation, as many of its systems have advanced in age and it lacks amenities. However, with the implementation of a comprehensive rehabilitation and code compliance plan, we believe the facility can remain an important part of the community. **It is our recommendation that this plan for rehabilitation be enacted in the next three to five years.**

## Introduction

In 2019, the Borough of Emmaus solicited a proposal from our firm focusing on the Emmaus Community Park Swimming Pool, as managed by the Emmaus Borough.

Our focus on the aquatic complex is a conditions assessment and feasibility study of the pools and their systems as well as the bathhouse and concession. This report will address function, equipment, structures, ADA, and code compliance and recommend solutions with budgetary projections to complete modifications, renovations, and enhancements. **All recommendations and conclusions will consider a multi-use facility concept approach.** The multi-use facility approach helps ensure activities are available for all age groups and activity levels. This approach aids in revenue production and contributes to the sustainability of the facility.

**The views of the owner were a foremost consideration in the formation of this study.**

**Aquatic Facility Design, Inc.’s** ability to evaluate, assess, and make recommendations on aquatic design and construction, is unique. Our foresight as a designer is invaluable as our staff and key personnel’s knowledge is based on experience in the design, maintenance, service, and construction of commercial swimming complexes.

### **I. Methodologies:**

Methodologies employed by Aquatic Facility Design, Inc. to complete this study include the following:

- A public participation process consisting of key person interviews and public meetings
- Inventory of existing outdoor facilities within the region
- Physical inspection of the existing pools and their functionality
- Core bore samplings
- Physical inspection of the equipment and piping as feasible
- Physical inspection of the bathhouse and concessions operation

In order to arrive at our conclusions, each of these methodologies has been used in this study in varying intensities and levels of application.

### **II. Objectives:**

The objective of this study is to assess our findings and to make experienced, professional recommendations for the modification / renovation of the complex. In that pursuit, the following is a list of items that have been studied, discussed, and reviewed in an effort to provide a document that will serve as a catalyst for making informed decisions.

#### **What will this Study tell you?**

- A site inventory and general description of existing conditions.
- What is the actual condition of the pools, their structures, and systems?
- Is the facility ADA and code compliant?

- Is the facility multi-use? Recommendations will be made throughout this study with the multi-use concept in mind. The multi-use facility approach helps insure activities are available for all age groups and activity levels. This approach aids in revenue production and contributes to the sustainability of the facility.
- What are the best solutions for this particular complex?
- What are the projected costs for the solutions to be recommended?
- What are the life expectancies, maintenance issues and ramifications of the solutions proposed?
- Recommendations for the implementation of phasing program.



## PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

### Public zoom meeting #1 held on April 20, 2022

- 15 participants were in attendance.
- Went over the different options/concepts and possible costs.
  - Comments made to eliminate Concept#2 (one body water)
  - Comment was made if 50 meter swim lanes were eliminated from the pool then 200-300 competitive swimmers would have to find a new location to train.
  - Comments were made questioning the need for the in-water seating along edge of pool and the possible interference it would cause to the people walking in the pool.
  - Comments were made about the proposed stainless steel gutter system questioning how hot they get and can you still sit along the pool edge?
  - Comments were made to show more pictures of the stainless steel system to better understand the effect it may have on people sitting along the pool.
  - Comment was made questioning if 100 people would fit in intermediate section of pool concept#3 (separate wading pool) for water aerobics?
  - Concept #4 (existing main pool) was most favorable concept choice.
  - Comments were made about slide being popular item at the pool.
  - Comments were made that balls are not allowed at the pool and would like to eliminate the basketball feature.
  - Comments were made about the placement of the ramp to enter the pool. People like to find their seat in the grassy area and then enter pool from that side if possible. Maybe add in a second entry/exit area of pool to accommodate?
  - Comments about the concern of the placement of umbrella with tables between wading pool and main pool. Concern of trash and food getting in the pool easily if people are eating there. And just blocking the flow of people through there.
  - Comment questioning where exactly would the lifeguard chairs get positioned?
  - Comment asking what the completion lane depth was in this concept?
  - Comment made asking to see a concept where the pool stays as is and just add to it a few of the necessary features needed like a built-in ramp? And if a ramp is in place would the pool supply a water wheelchair to use with ramp?
  - Comments were made about parking. More handicap parking is needed. More parking closer to the pool in general is needed especially for people with small kids and strollers.
  - Comments about the concession area being hard to walk to. It is hard for people to walk uphill to get to the concession area.

## I. Existing Pools and Their Systems: - See Drawing EX-1 hereafter

### A. The Main Pool

The main pool is constructed of steel reinforced gunite concrete with marcite plaster and then paint applied as a finish. It is a straight configuration with 50 meter lanes and an attached deep well. Depths of water varies from approximately 2'4" in the shallow section to a depth of approximately 10 feet in the deep well. The pool consists of approximately 16,810 sq. ft. of surface area. The pool has a recirculation piping system, consisting of a concrete gutter system, and a single deep well drain intake box. Underground piping appears to be primarily PVC. There is one (1) set of access stairs in the shallow end and one (1) ADA drop in ramp. The pool has an ADA chair lift available.

The main pool offers six (6) 50 meter race lanes and three (3) longer lanes. One (1) diving board is present in the deep well area, as well as a single flume slide and zip line at the deep end of the lap lanes. There is a series of stainless-steel ladders for access. A poured concrete deck surrounds the pool. No additional amenities exist. See Fig. 1 & 2. User load for the existing main pool area is calculated at 1334 patrons. Fourteen (14) lifeguards are required to monitor the pool with a minimum of 1 in reserve.

**a. Filtration/Chemical Equipment and Systems - Main Pool**

The main pool filtration system consists of a below grade recirculation pump and motor unit linked to a pressure sand system. The chemical system consists of a liquid chlorine system for sanitation. A muriatic acid system regulates pH control.

**B. Wading Pool**

The wading pool is constructed of concrete with layers of paint applied as a finish. It is approximately 11" to 1'2" inches of depth. The pool consists of approximately 4173 sq. ft. of surface area. The wading pool is step in with a portable ramp. The pool has an underground recirculation piping system consisting of surface skimming intake boxes, a filtered water return system, and a bottom drain system. Underground piping appears to be primarily of PVC composition. Concrete deck surrounds the pool. See Fig. 3 & 4

User load for the existing wading pool area is calculated at 347 patrons. Two (2) lifeguards are currently required.

a. Filtration/Chemical Equipment and Systems – Wading Pool

The wading pool filtration is a pressure cartridge system. Sanitation is achieved via a liquid chlorine system with muriatic acid used for pH control.

C. Main/Pool Filtration/Chemical Building

The pump and filtration systems, as well as the chemical systems for both pools are located in separate filter buildings. See Fig. 5a & Fig. 5b.

The Bathhouse structure consists of a cmu building that house the men’s and women’s restrooms. Admissions, first aid, and offices are housed within. See Fig. 6 & 7. The interiors are painted concrete block, with a concrete slab floor. See Fig. 8 through 11.

#### E. Concession Building (reference Fig. 12)

Concessions are offered in a separate building. The concession stand is owned & managed by the Borough. See Fig. 13 & 14.

The concessions building is in good condition and is well maintained.

- a. The concession food prep area consists of:
- Multiple serving windows serving the park and pool.
  - Commercial refrigerators, coolers, ice machine, drink and ice cream cases, stainless steel three-bowl sink and separate hand washing sink, prep tables, griddles, grilling surfaces, fryers, microwave, food warming lights, coffee maker and novelty equipment such as soft pretzel machines, pizza rack, hotdog rack, and a snow cone machine. See Fig. 15 & 16.
  - Currently the food served is a combination of pre-packaged and prepared offerings such as:  
Fried food, grilled food, pizza, sandwiches, ice cream, and a variety of snacks and drinks. See Fig. 17

F. Grounds/Amenities (reference Fig. 18)

- A perimeter chain link fence with multiple entry points contains the complex, separating it from the adjoining park.
- Outside the pools' perimeter decks is grass area.
- A park like setting, playground and small, patron parking lot is adjacent the complex.
- Area lighting is present.

## G. Discoveries Upon Completion of Assessment and Inspection

Code and Standards Deficiencies – the following is a summary of complex codes and standards deficiencies:

### Main Pool

1. Americans with Disabilities Act requires two (2) accessible means of entry to the main pool. A first means via the chair lift is present. A second means via a drop in ramp is available as well. This should be a permanent and integral ramp.
2. The main pool deep well drain box is a single - non VGB compliant drain.

### Wading Pool

1. The wading pool is a step in design and therefore non ADA compliant. A drop in ramp access, as is present, is functional but is not acceptable by code. The pool needs to be a beach entry design.
2. The single floor drain is non VGB compliant.

### Bathhouse

1. Men's Restrooms
  - a. No ADA urinal
  - b. No ADA sink
  - c. No ADA shower
  - d. No privacy doors on showers
  - e. No private dressing areas
  - f. No hot water at sink
  - g. Fixture counts do not match current user loads.
2. Women's Restrooms
  - a. No grab rails on ADA toilet
  - b. No ADA sink
  - c. Missing a soap dispenser for sink
  - d. No hot water at sinks
  - e. No privacy curtains or doors on regular showers
  - f. Fixture counts do not match current user loads.

### General Bathhouse

Ceiling shows evidence membrane roof is leaking.

## Concessions

1. The three bowl sink area should be larger & have more storage space.
2. Floor coating should be a more cleanable surface.
3. More stainless steel counter tops required.
4. A cold bar area should be installed for lettuce, salsa, etc.

## Existing Facility Patron user Loads

The existing main pool will accommodate a total of 1334 patrons. Fourteen lifeguards are required.

The existing wading pool will accommodate 347 patrons. Two lifeguards are required.

## H. Shell Structures

### Core Sample Borings

Core Sample Borings were taken from the Main Pool shell to assess the condition of the structures.

The results are as follows:

### Main Pool

**Floor:** Two (2) 4-inch Borings were taken. The floor averages between 6 and 3 inches thick. Samples indicate Steel Reinforced Gunite Concrete Construction. See Fig. 19, Floor 1 & Floor 2

**Walls:** Two (2) 4-inch Borings were taken. The walls average 4 to 8 inches thick. Samples indicate Steel Reinforced Gunite Concrete Construction.

### Conclusion

All Borings yielded consistent results, except for wall boring #1, (Fig. 20, Wall 1). This Boring revealed a prior construction pool wall remaining.

## II. Recommendations - Modification of Existing Facility

- 1) Reconstruction and refurbishment of the main pool is required.
- 2) A new, separate wading pool is recommended to be constructed to replace the existing.
- 3) A new children's splash pad between the two bodies of water will be an optional addition to the facility.

The current configuration of the main pool permits only general swimming or wading and does not meet the public's expectations of a "modern" complex. Furthermore, the current configuration will not allow the management of the facility to properly implement such programs as the public may require or demand, thus lowering the appeal of the complex to many members of the community and even excluding some.

A contemporary aquatics complex will provide access and activities for all age groups and activity levels. **The goal of this complex is to provide equal opportunities for educational, social, and recreational types of programs.** This would include, but is not limited to, activities such as swimming lessons, water sports, senior fitness classes, lap swimming, splash hops, private parties etc., as well as a variety of recreational play type activities.

### Creation of a Multi-use Pool Complex

#### A. Refurbishment of Main Pool – **Phase I** – *See Drawing CS-1 hereafter*

##### Main Pool

The main pool is well maintained and of sound structural condition and accepting of long term improvements.

The pool shell will be sandblasted and all weak and hollow areas will be removed and regunited.

The pool top with the concrete gutter will be removed and a stainless steel gutter system and new piping system will be installed. (*see Typical Gutter Section hereafter*)

The shallow end of the pool will have a new ADA ramp and stairs installed. These will be integral to the design.

Benches with sun shades will be added to the pools footprint as a respite from the sun.

The intermediate area of the pool will have five (5) 50 meter lanes for training purposes or lap swimming. These long lanes are a unique asset to the community and to the surrounding area for the purposes of competitive training. The current zip line will remain and floatable sharks and turtles will be added for play.

The deep well area will feature diving, a climbing wall, and a single flume slide.

a. Recirculation/Plumbing Systems – Pool Top

The existing plumbing/recirculation lines are in an aged condition. **Replacement of all existing pool recirculation lines is recommended.**

The recommended method of replacement of the piping systems of the pool is with a new **stainless-steel perimeter recirculation system** (*see Typical Gutter Section hereafter*)

A new bottom drain influent system would also be placed.

b. Filtration/Sanitation System

At the time of this writing the existing filtration system could be reused as it is in suitable condition and the size of the pool is not changing.

A UV system, in conjunction with a bulk liquid chlorine system for sanitation, as well as, an acid system for pH adjustment, is recommended. Sanitation systems will be controlled and dispensed by a computerized system. The current chlorine and pH systems can be reused.

c. Decking

Construction requirements for the reconstructed or refurbished pool, along with the installation parameters of the perimeter gutter system, will require replacement of the concrete decking.

New decking complete with trench drain system and deck safety signage would be installed. A new system of lifeguard stands and ladders would be installed.

Renovated Main Pool Data:

The newly configured and renovated Main Pool will accommodate 1273 users. Fourteen (14) lifeguards are required with a minimum of 1 in reserve recommended during recreational use. It will be **16,810 sq. ft.** for users age 0-100.

A Schedule of Proposed Features for Main Pool as follows:

1. **“Basketball Hoop”** is fun for adults and older children. Deck mounted and easily removable during the offseason.
2. **“Floatables”** are a facility favorite and provide hours of play for a variety of ages. They also reinforce the theme of the facility.
3. A **“Closed Flume Slide”** is positioned in the competition area and is an added attraction for the intermediate age group.
4. **“Diving Board”**, at regulation size, will be placed in the Well Area.
5. A **“Wall Spray”** is placed on the deck and has a fountain-like curve of water from the side of the wall into the pool area.

6. A “**Climbing Wall**” allows older children and adults to get a rock-climbing experience, without the fear of falling. The panel system is configured to the depth of your deep well. The panels can be interchangeable so it’s a different experience every season.

## **B. Construction of a New Wading Pool – Phase I – See Drawing CS-1 hereafter**

### **New Children’s Wading Pool**

A new zero depth entry wading pool will be built adjacent to the existing bathhouse & concession area and the newly renovated main pool.

The new wading area is designed for children ages 0-6 and their caregivers. It begins at a zero depth and progresses to a level main area with a depth of eighteen inches. This area hosts multiple children’s activities and play features with in water seating and a caregiver’s lounge area. Sun shade umbrellas are added for the comfort of the children and their caregivers alike.

Two lifeguards will be stationed to oversee the children’s area.

### **A Schedule of Proposed Features for Wading Pool as follows:**

1. “**Themed Mini Squirts**” are located on the zero-entry. They are a fun and interactive play feature that is both a climbable and water spray in one.
2. “**Pop Jets**” are located on the zero-entry. Pop Jets are fountain like ground spray features that children can interact with. Step on one and it causes the others to shoot higher into the air, step on two & the spray will go even higher. This is something that one child or several can play in at a time. This interactive water feature works on the simple principle of cause & effect. Pop Jets will be enjoyed by all age groups.
3. “**Submarine Toddler Slide**” This fun and realistic slide is geared for younger children. This soft sculpted foam slide is sealed with a rubber coating, which is UV and antibacterial resistant making this slide safer, healthier and increasing the life expectancy of the slide. The rubber-coated foam encases a stainless-steel support system, which provides structure to the slide.
4. Two “**Wall sprays**” are placed on the deck and has a fountain-like curve of water from the side of the wall into the pool area.
5. “**In Water Bench Seating**” where children and caregivers alike can comfortably rest from inside the wading area. Decorative finishes coordinate in a fun and natural way.
6. “**Lounge Shelf with In-Water Chairs**” provide a relaxing spot for caregivers to watch their children in the shade. Sun Shades overhead create a resort-like atmosphere.
7. “**Poly Palm**” water gently streams down each palm leaf and rains down onto waterplayers below.

## **C. Optional Splash Pad**

A splash pad for children ages 0-8 will be an option between the main pool and the new wading pool. It has no standing water and requires no lifeguards. It will feature various spray toys and activities.

#### A Schedule of Proposed Features for Splash Pad as follows:

1. “Cool Sticks” sprays in every direction from multiple nozzles at varying heights.
2. “Over N Under Sprays” is a fountain-like spray curving water from the side of the wall into the pool area, creating an archway.
3. “Geyserino” is a flush mount spray which shoots water high into the air.
4. “Beach Ball Sprays” are a large beach ball that gently sprays a refreshing shower.
5. “Water Flower” is a ground spray that creates a gentle bubbling effect.

#### D. Bathhouse- Phase I or II – See Drawing CS-2 hereafter

The existing bathhouse will be amended with the addition of new toilet fixtures, showers, etc. to meet the user loads for the newly renovated complex. In addition, two family changing bathrooms will be added. New floor finishes will be added and cosmetic upgrades will take place such as fresh paint.

A new membrane roof will need to be installed.

#### E. Concession Operations - Phase I

Current concession operations are managed by Emmaus Borough and are well run with an expansive menu. The concessions operation is managed by recdesk and is currently being upgraded. No operational improvements are being recommended at this time.

Physical improvements which are recommended are:

- Application of a more cleanable floor treatment such as epoxy
- Installation of a larger three bowl sink
- New stainless steel countertops in areas where there are none
- A cold bar for lettuce, salsa, etc.
- Café area seating and changes to the ADA approaches to the interior & exterior serving windows.

The addition of a portable grill cart for food preparation is recommended. This cart can prepare hamburgers, hot dogs, chicken patties etc., and be wheeled around the facility to promote food sales. It will bring a “cookout” party atmosphere to the facility.

### III. Synopsis

It is our conclusion that the Emmaus Community Pool Complex is a substantial asset to the Borough of Emmaus. The facility is due for renovation, as its systems have advanced in age and it lacks amenities. However, with the implementation of a comprehensive rehabilitation plan, we believe the life of the facility can be restored and extended substantially.

The proposed renovation plan and options utilize all of the strong points that exist within the complex. To these strong points are added remediation and renovations designed to add long-term functionality and usability to the complex with minimal maintenance. **All recommendations are made with the multi-use facility complex concept in mind.** Recommended amenities and play features are included in the proposed renovation plans to maximize public participation and usage. The proposed renovations are designed to not only provide substantial structural, mechanical and cosmetic upgrades, but also reconfigure the complex to allow for the creation and implementation of new programs and activities.

#### IV. Budgetary Considerations/Phasing and Options

The following budgetary projections are componentized to allow them to be utilized in part or as a whole, depending upon prevailing fiscal conditions.

##### REFURBISHED COMPLEX – MULTI-USE -see Drawing CS-1 hereafter

- **Life Expectancy of Improvements is Approximately 30-35+ Years (Major Pool Systems)**

##### Main Pool – Phase I Refurbished

- Refurbish main pool body and deep well \$ 250,000.00
- Place new ADA ramp and stairs as well as new seating benches \$ 180,000.00
- Restructure pool joints \$ 60,000.00
- Installation of new stainless steel perimeter recirculation system, new bottom drain system, reuse of existing filtration system, and associated feature plumbing systems \$ 400,000.00
- Sand blast, surface repair, and paint \$ 155,000.00
- Provide and place new decking around entire perimeter with drain system and deck features (ladders, lifeguard stands, etc.) \$ 130,000.00
- Provide and place play features & shade structures to the new pool \$ 75,000.00



## V. In Closing




